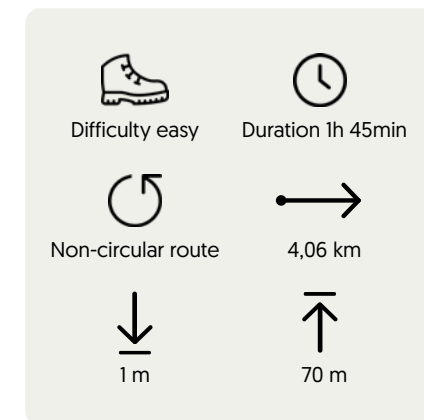
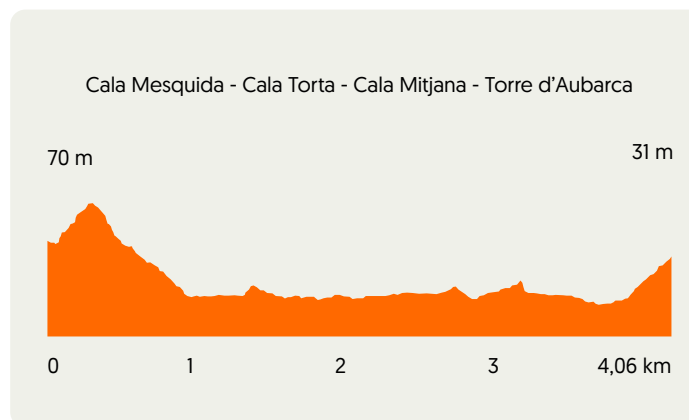




# MALLORCA EXCURSIONS

Cala Mesquida - Cala Torta -  
Cala Mitjana - Torre d'Aubarca





Starting at the gorgeous Cala Mesquida beach, located just a few metres from VIVA Cala Mesquida Resort & Spa and Vanity Suite & Spa, you can enjoy an easy, pretty excursion along the Mallorca coastline with gorgeous landscapes. It's an easy trip that'll take you to the Torre d'Aubarca, one of the watchtowers that borders the coast of Mallorca.

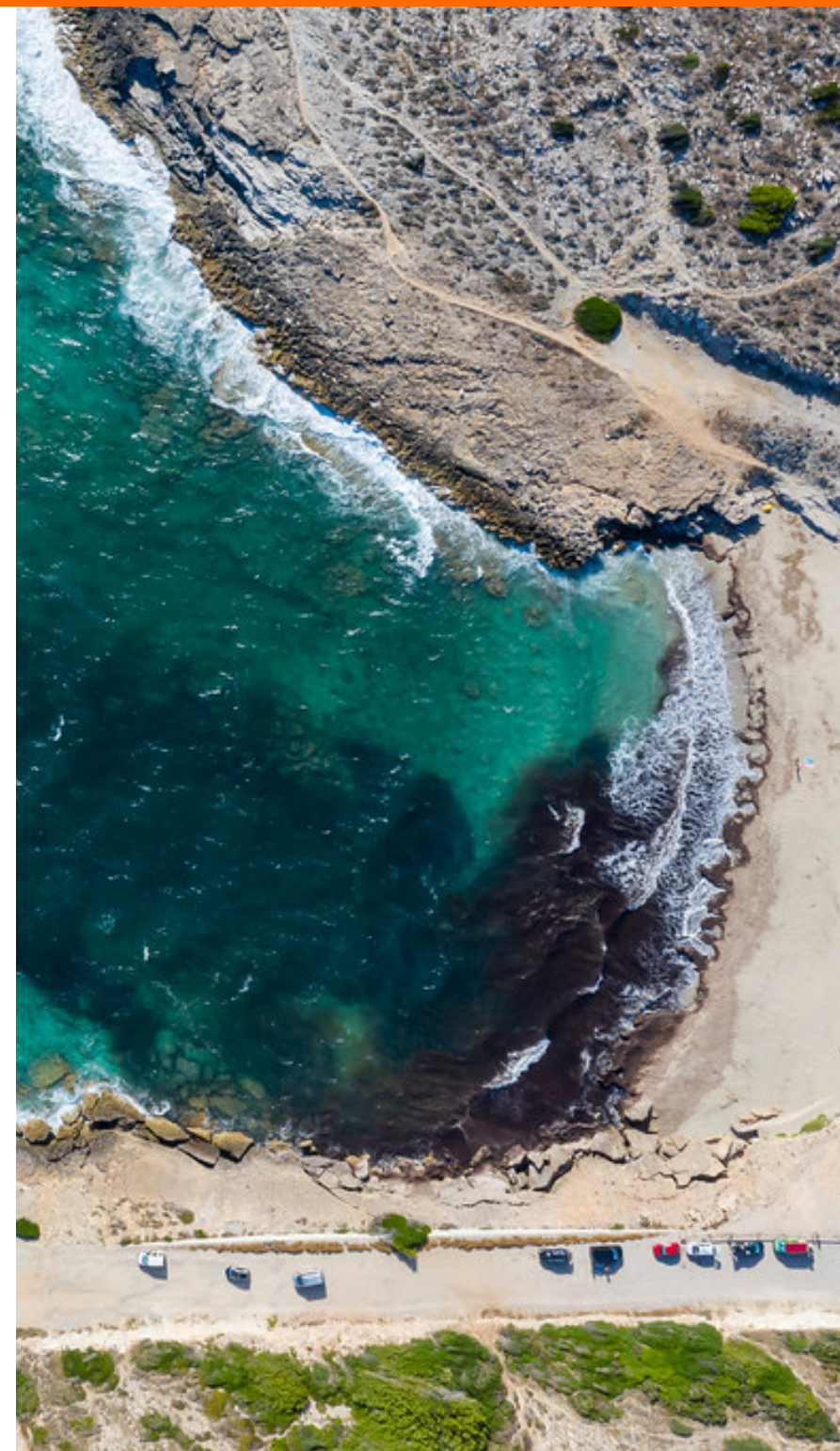
The Torre d'Aubarca or Torre d'es Matzoc was built to make sure that the Menorca channel was in view during the British invasion on the neighbouring island. Today, it's an idyllic spot for enjoying the sunset with a spectacular view of the Mediterranean coast and the dwarf palms and reeds that are unique to Mallorca.



So, put your trainers on and get ready to enjoy some incredible landscapes!

Start the route at Cala Mesquida, taking the path located on the left-hand side when looking out to sea. You'll see a clearly marked path.

Walk for a fair few kilometres without leaving the path, following the signposts you'll see along the way. You can't get lost.







After an hour of walking slowly, you'll get to Playa de Cala Torta, one of the locals' favourite beaches. During the summer months, its beach bar is the perfect place to enjoy fresh fish brought straight off the fishing boats by the local fisherman. Totally authentic and magical. Whatever the season, take advantage to wander around and enjoy the gulls! After this quick stop, continue the excursion towards Cala Mitjana.

Cala Mitjana is a paradisiacal cove with sand, clear water and natural surroundings so pure it feels like a journey back in time.

Here you'll start the climb up to the Torre d'Aubarca, passing through a pine forest. As long as you don't stray from the coast and make sure you follow the signposts, you'll have no trouble getting there.

On the route, you'll begin to see the Torre as you go around the bends. This is your final destination where you can stop and take a rest.

Between Cala Mitjana and the Torre d'Aubarca, you can enjoy the view of the island of Menorca. If you do the excursion in the evening, you'll be able to admire the lights on the neighbouring island.



Follow the path – you're nearly there! At the end, you'll get to the Torre d'Aubarca or Torre d'es Matzoc, where you'll be able to take in the panoramic view of Mallorca. The gorgeous cliffs aren't dangerous and from there you can enjoy all of Mallorca's beauty.

Now you're reenergised, it's time to start the descent back to the hotel. You've earned a good rest at our restaurant, La Terraza. As you'll have already seen, you'll be able to enjoy the sea from its superb location!
